ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

We have the honour to invite you to the 2024 Edition of the **International Conference “Agriculture for Life - Life for Agriculture”**, taking place under the general theme **“Land and water management - Challenges for agriculture”**. The event was initiated by the **University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest** in 2012, and will be held in Bucharest, Romania, between **06th and 08th of June 2024**. We are proud that our Conference included in each of its previous editions more than 800 papers and hosted more than 3000 authors and experts from 43 countries worldwide.

The world population is expected to reach almost 10 billion people by the midcentury. More than half live and eat in urban areas, and experts claim this number will exceed 70% by 2050, causing 80% of all food to be consumed in cities (UN, 2018). From a global perspective, there is a convergence of factors that are putting unprecedented pressure on land and water resources, resulting in a range of shocks to production and supply chains. Agriculture is required to keep up with the rising demand for food while preserving or improving sustainability. To reverse trends in land and water degradation and promote inclusive growth, we need to share and learn from each other's experiences. This reflects FAO's strategic framework aspirations: “better production, better nutrition, a better environment and a better life”. Therefore, the University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest aims to continue its annual meetings on life sciences and social sciences, offering researchers, business leaders, government and EU officials the opportunity to share their innovative ideas and research results to address global challenges on a scientific basis.

The conference program combines seven sessions and events that are designed specifically to promote interactions among participants, through Oral and Poster sessions, Workshop discussions, optional social activities and professional visits. Aiming to keep a high level of interactions among participants, these sessions are customized in such a program that encourages live discussions following the convenient presentations throughout the 3 conference days.

The International Conference “Agriculture for Life - Life for Agriculture” gathers researchers and professionals from the agriculture field, which allows them to share their research results, innovative ideas and practical experience related to agriculture, life and the environment. Participants have the opportunity to interact with experts from all around the world, and thus become part of a unique scientific community.

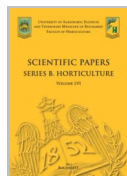

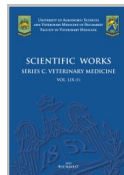

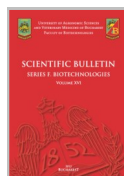

Participation at the conference is **mandatory** in order for the paper to be evaluated, **but does not guarantee publication acceptance. Only papers** accepted in the peer review process pertaining to registered authors that participated at the conference can be included in **the scientific journals**.

Should a paper be submitted by a **team of authors** and co-authors, **attendance is mandatory** for a minimum of **one** representative of aforementioned team.

Submission of the paper implies that it is an original article and is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
